

## 13 SHARING THE GOSPEL

### INTRODUCTION:

The result of our salvation experience is sufficient to convince us that the world is in the most extreme need of God's salvation through the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. We understand and concur with Paul when he said in **Romans 1:16 “For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.”** God not only has the power to save and change individual lives, but He has the power through His gospel to save and change homes, communities a country and the world.

If believers will consider themselves Disciples of Christ, then sharing the gospel is one of many means by which a true disciple follows and serves the Lord and those that are lost.

This lesson is designed so that the student knows the most important talking points needed while giving out the gospel. It is important for the student to know what the relevant Bible verses are and what they mean. Knowing what the Bible verses are and what they mean will guide one's explanation of the gospel in the **simplest and clearest manner possible**. **2 Timothy 2:24-26 24 And the servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient, 25 In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth; 26 And that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will.**
